

SEWING MACHINE TABLE-STAND ASSEMBLY

- 1. Attach the bottom brace and the back brace to the two K-legs with bolts and nuts loosely.
- 2. Attach the treadle (pedal) to the bottom brace and locate it approximately under the machine needle.
- 3. If necessary, attach the second, small pedal (for foot lifter, if provided) approximately 6" to the right of the large treadle.
- 4. Place the table top on an assembly work surface with the bottom side on top. Place the assembled stand on top of the table's bottom side, and locate it approximately 3"—4" from the operator's left side, and 1"—2" from the front (operator's side). Attach to the table with 8 wood screws.
- 5. Attach motor with the bolts supplied with the motor.
- 6. Attach drawer with nails or screws 1" from the operator's right edge of the table.
- 7. Attach treadle extension to the treadle.
- 8. Attach treadle rod to the treadle extension and to the motor arm.
- 9. Attach the motor on/off switch to the right side of the table, close to the front edge.
- 10. Tighten all bolts and nuts, and turn the assembled stand right side up on the floor.
- 11. Install the sewing machine.
